1. AGE:

The minimum Age is 18 years and the Maximum aged is 44 years, in terms of (Rule-12(1) (a) (v) of Telangana State and Subordinate service Rules 1996). The Minimum and Maximum Age shall be reckoned from 01.07.2026 with the following relaxations allowed for reckoning the maximum age limit as per rules.

- i) For SCs, STs, BCs &EWS : 05 years
- ii) For Ex Service men : 03 years in addition to length of Service in Armed Force (applicable Only for the posts of Medical Officers)
- iii) For NCC : Who worked as Instructor in NCC Relaxation of (3) years and length of Service in NCC
- iv) Disabled : 10 years.

The Rule of reservation in respect of Community, Disability, Ex- service Men/Women shall be strictly observed as per the TS state and Subordinate Services Rules, 1996, read with the relevant Specific Rules applicable.

The Rule of Reservation of Local candidates is applicable as per Presidential order, and posts shall be filed among the candidates who belong to the State of Telangana only.

2. METHOD OF RECRUITMENT:

Selection shall be made based on following Criteria.

- i. Total Marks are 100 of which 90 marks will be allotted basing on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination and 10 marks will be awarded for the age. Weight-age for age will be reckoned from 18 years of age of the candidate 0.5 mark will be awarded for one completed year of age with a maximum of 10 marks. The age will be reckoned as on 01.07.2026 (Example 1. If a candidate completes 20 years as on 01.07.2026, he/she will be awarded 1.0 mark; Example 2. If a candidate completes 30 years of age as on 01.07.2026, he/she will be awarded 6.0 marks, Example 3. If a candidate completes 38 years of age as on 01.07.2026, he/she will be awarded 10.0 marks)
- ii. Provisional Merit Lists will be prepared based on the marks obtained with above said criteria, and displayed on Kumurambheem Asifabad district official website www.asifabad.telangana.gov.in. for transparency and also calling for objections.
- iii. Selection List will be prepared from the finalized Merit list duly following the Rule of Reservation (ROR) and presidential order and also SC-ST reservation rules.
- iv. The selected candidates shall maintain the Headquarters.

3. RULE OF RESERVATION:

- i. Rule of Reservation in respect of Community, Disability, Ex-service men/Women shall be strictly observed as ordered by the Government of Telangana from time to time.
- ii. 33 1/3% reservation for women will be applicable as per the orders issued by Government in G.O.Ms.No.3 dept for Women, Children, Disabled & Sr. Citizens (Prog.I) dated 10.02.2024 and in G.O.Ms.No. 35, Genl. Admn.(ser.D) Dept., Dated: 13.02.2024.

- iii. The Rule of Reservations to local candidates is applicable as per the Presidential order and also SC-ST reservation rules.
- iv. The vacant posts shall be filled as per the applicable Rule of Reservation (RoR).
- v. The vacancies for the posts mentioned in G.O.68, falling in Scheduled Areas should be filled exclusively with the Local Scheduled Tribes.

4. HOW TO APPLY:

- i. Application forms along with the instructions can be download from the website www.asifabad.telangana.gov.in.
- ii. Filled in application form shall be submitted in person or through registered post to O/o District Medical & Health Officer, IDOC Complex Kumurambheem Asifabad, Applications which are received after due date will be summarily rejected. The District Selection Committee is not responsible for postal delays.
- iii. Application/ Registration Fees to be paid in form of Demand Draft (DD) in favor of the District Medical & Health Officer, Kumurambheem Asifabad, which should be enclosed to the application.
- iv. Self-Attested copies of the following certificates should be enclosed along with the Application Form:

5. GENERAL INFORMATION TO THE CANDIDATES:

- i. The District Collector reserves the right to change/modify/cancel the selection process at any time during the process and the decision of the District Collector will be final and binding.
- ii. The Mode of Appointment is on Outsourcing basis or Contract basis for a period of 1 year or till the actual need ceases whichever is earlier.
- iii. No. TA/DA will be paid to the candidates for attending the interviews.
- iv. Appointments will work under the overall administrative control of CH&FW and MD, NHM
- v. Candidates selected under Outsourcing mode shall be appointed through, Outsourcing agency.
- vi. The Posts notified are not permanent/regular Government posts and are purely temporary.

- vii. The selected candidates will be intimated through email/official communication.
- viii. The selected candidates may have to perform tours.
- ix. Their performance will be evaluated from time to time and also the same will be considered for extension/ Termination of their service, in case of future requirements.
- x. The employment is subject to disciplinary/codal rules and in case of any deviation, employment is liable for termination.

6. SELECTION COMMITTEE:

The Recruitment is made on contract basis and the contract is initially for a period of one year and renewal will be as per the need and NHM yearly plan (PIP) and also subject to satisfactory performance, However, every year new contract has to signed and valid for the period as indicated in the contract. The Recruitment shall be done by the District Selection Committee on behalf of the
